

It's almost time to collect your free native tree from Rotary!

Thank you for registering to plant a native tree and helping keep Pelham green through the Rotary Club of Fonthill Tree Planting Initiative. This event is in celebration of Earth Day 2024, in partnership with the Town of Pelham, Pelham Advocates for Trees and Habitat (PATH) and Niagara Peninsula Conservation.

WHERE TO PICK UP: Trees will be available for pick up on Saturday, April 20, in the courtyard outside Meridian Community Centre, near the intersection of Wellspring Way and Meridian Way. Look for the Town of Pelham Eco-Expo signs and tents.

The trees are in 6" pots courtesy of Willowbrook Nurseries and will be accompanied by a bag of mulch, generously provided by Safe Tree Ltd. Planting and care instructions will also be provided.

WHERE TO PARK: To prevent traffic issues, we encourage you to park in either the main parking lot on the south side, or the overflow parking at the east end of MCC – we will have people to help get your tree and mulch to your vehicle.

WHEN TO PICK UP: To facilitate a smooth flow and minimize congestion, we've set designated times for pick-up of trees and mulch, according to the type of tree ordered:

9 – 9:45 Maple

9:45 - 10:30 Tulip tree

10:30 - 11:15 Serviceberry

11:15 - noon Oak and Hackberry

If these times are not suitable for you, you may come anytime between 9 and noon, but please be patient.

As mentioned on the registration form, while every effort will be made to provide you with the type of tree you requested, supply is limited. Please have a backup in mind should the tree you hoped for not be available.

Thank you for helping the Rotary Club of Fonthill celebrate Earth Day by enriching the canopy in Pelham and supporting biodiversity and a resilient environment for all to enjoy.
